# SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

A separate Olympic College Scholarship Application is required for **EACH** Scholarship for which you apply. Read and review the application form carefully. Fill in all blanks and answer all questions on the application.

Make sure that you;

- ❑ Identify the scholarship for which you are applying.
- ❑ Attach a copy of your most current academic transcripts.
- ❑ Attach a personal letter describing your goals, merit, and need for the scholarship (Please limit your letter to no more than one, typed, single-spaced page).
- ❑ Attach one letter of recommendation from someone who can speak to your qualifications and need for the scholarship for which you are applying.
- ❑ Sign and date the application.
- ❑ Unless the scholarship description instructs otherwise, return your completed application to the Olympic College Financial Aid Office.

**Note: If the scholarship description instructs you to send your application directly to a listed address, do NOT deliver that application to the OC Financial Aid Office.**

**Application Deadline:** *Unless otherwise indicated* by an outside donor, or in the current Olympic College Listing of Scholarships Webpage, all scholarships that use the Olympic College scholarship application form must be ***received*** by the organization or address specified in the scholarship description by 4:00 pm, ***March 31*** of each year. Late or incomplete scholarship application packages will not be considered in the award process.

**General Scholarship Information:** The Olympic College Listing of Scholarships webpage is a resource for students seeking information on scholarships available to them. All of the scholarships listed on the webpage have previously been offered or referred to Olympic College by donors. There is a possibility that a scholarship may not be offered by a donor for the upcoming academic year, and students interested in scholarship opportunities should not limit their scholarship search to our scholarship pamphlet. Additional scholarship resources that students should investigate in their scholarship search include; libraries, the Internet, individual colleges, and the Olympic College Foundation.

**Administration of Scholarships:** Olympic College does not have administrative control over all of the scholarships in the Olympic College Listing of Scholarships webpage. Several of the listed scholarships are awarded by specific donors. Applicants need to **read** all scholarship information carefully and ensure that their application packages are correctly completed and submitted for consideration.
