Welcome! All businesses, individuals, and other organizations are encouraged to compete for contractual opportunities with the Bremerton School District. Bremerton School District is looking to expand their options for the infant/toddler/Pre-School childcare center located at West Sound Technical Skills Center.

The Infant/Toddler/ Pre-School Child Care Center will be owned and operated by an independent contractor who will enter an interagency agreement with the school district. The rental with the school district will be negotiated to include in-kind services. The site will be used as a training facility for Early Childhood Education students enrolled at WST. The Infant/Toddler/Pre-school Child Care Center will carry their own insurance, liability and adhere to all state and district requirements.

The Infant/Toddler/Pre-School Child Care Center will enter an interagency agreement with the school district to join our early literacy community efforts to provide children with the early reading foundation skills necessary for success in kindergarten.

This includes:

- Incorporate the district/early childhood community's common reading curriculum (Open Court) into the child care structure.
- Participation in our Early Childhood Care and Education Professional Learning Community.
